The 2020 round of population censuses conducted in the circumstance of Covid-19 Pandemic outbreak in late December 2019 that has affected to many countries



The 2020 round of population censuses have been affected negatively by Covid-19 Pandemic

Contacting to respondents

Methodology of population census data collection is face to face interview

During Covid-19 Pandemic, local authorities impose travel restrictions







H's difficult to contact households and respondents to collect information





The 2020 round of population censuses

Population censuses typically use one of two approaches:

De facto

De jure



It's difficult to define right respondents to be counted in the context of pandemic



Defining De jure population in one area is more difficult and less accuracy during Covid-19 pandemic than normal circumstance



The data collected by population censuses during Covid-19 Pandemic does not fully reflect the number of people in the normal reality of a country (in a typical year)





→ Programs and make policies for
→ development in forthcoming years



Covid-19 pandemic effects to quality of data collected from population census

In the context of the Covid-19 outbreak, respondents and interviewers tend to involve in data collection process less

During the Covid-19 Pandemic, national resources prioritize on disease prevention and control (especially financial resource)







Therefore, the 2020 census is limited by budget and human resources



Technological application

The 2020 round of population censuses implemented in the context of survey mode innovation and information technology application

Resources for innovation are limited due to Covid-19 Pandemic that affects the progress and quality of the census To overcome the challenges, countries have been adapting to the pandemic
