1. Background

National Institute of Statistics (NIS) is an official statistics organization as government agency is to implement the statistical law and regulations such data collection, analyzing, reporting and disseminating of population census data.

NIS has conducted the Population Census every 10 years, called the "General Population Census of Cambodia (GPCC)" started from 1998 after Khmer Rough Regime that conducted after 36 years of the 1962 population census.





The population pyramid graphically displays a population's age and sex composition. Horizontal bars present the percentage of males and females in each age group.




Population Pyramid of Cambodia, 2019

Population Pyramid of Cambodia, 2008




Population Pyramid of Cambodia, 1998

- Editing and Coding and Data Capture

Editing and coding and data entry have been the most affected activities with the majority of infection. That's why two data entry operators, who tested positive by Health agent, send them to work from home and not allow them to go outside until the health agent's re-testing with negative and data entry room has been closed temporarily.

All staff were allowed to work from home either data editing, coding and data entry.

Good networking with Provincial Department of Planning (PDP) and other related bodies for conducting the population census data editing coding and data entry was set up with the implementation of the restrict codes and rules/regulation by the Ministry of Health, to avoid of COVID19 pandemic.







+ Editing and Coding

The editing and coding process involved 150 staff and was initially scheduled to be completed around January 2020. However, this process took slightly longer than planned and, to minimize delays, the National Institute of Statistics requested additional officials from other units within the Ministry of Planning. With the assistance of these extra technical officers and management staff, the editing and coding process was completed by the end of June 2020. Once the editing and coding was completed, the census questionnaires were transferred over to the data entry team.



+ Data Capture

The data entry team consisted of 100 keyboard operators working under 10 supervisors. Approximately one week after the editing and coding process started, data entry staff were given a thorough training on data entry procedures and the CSPro data entry software. Due to the network connection, data entry started about a month and half after the editing and coding process.

+ Data Capture

The data entry was estimated to be completed within nine months but was ultimately delayed by the COVID-19 pandemic. To minimize delays, the NIS recruited around 200 university students in Phnom Penh. These additional recruits helped to accelerate data entry activities by working a half-day and a full day on Saturday and Sunday. As a result, data entry was completed by the end of June 2020.
