In addition, discussions regarding field surveys will be covered such as approaches to implementing field surveys through operational control systems, and new opportunities for increasing quality and speed in internet and mobile connectivity, and technological innovations for census data collection can be included in this session.</i></p>
Day 2 (Dec 3)	09:30-11:00	Session 2	<p><b>Topic</b>      <b>Data Processing: Capture, Coding, E&amp;I</b></p> <p><i>The session will provide opportunities to share the processing of all census data, which encompasses everything from the receipt of questionnaires to the creation of an accurate and complete census database such as questionnaire registration, imaging and data capture, editing, error correction, coding, imputation (E&amp;I), weighting, and final response rates.</i></p>
	11:00-12:30	Session 3	<p><b>Topic</b>      <b>Census Evaluation: Activities and Data</b></p> <p><i>This session covers census evaluation of the overall activities such as census planning, implementation, budget, and accuracy evaluation of data such as post-enumeration survey (PES).</i></p>
	12:30-14:00	Session 4	<p><b>Topic</b>      <b>Data Analysis and Utilization</b></p> <p><i>In this session, the application and experience of census data analysis, and utilization will be presented. An analysis of population dynamics, demographic characteristics, socio-economic characteristics, SDGs with population census, and the status of household and housing can also be included.</i></p>
Day 3 (Dec 4)	09:30-11:00	Session 5	<p><b>Topic</b>      <b>Data Dissemination</b></p> <p><i>Methods of dissemination to the public by seeking ways of publishing census results in a timely and accessible manner with high data quality standards, including experiences with online (PC, mobile) and offline data services, and public use sample data (PUMS) will be discussed in this session.</i></p>
	11:00-12:30	Session 6	<p><b>Topic</b>      <b>Census Planning</b></p> <p><i>This session is to share the overall plans for next census design, and the implementation of the operational plans and strategies for the next census taking, and efforts to make improvements for conducting the next census.</i></p>
