

## Access from the Airports to the Venue (Keio Plaza Hotel)

### 1. From Haneda Airport

(1) By Airport Limousine Bus (←simple and easy way)

Duration: approx. 70 minutes.

Fare: Adult JPY 1,300

(2) By Train: Keikyu Line/JR Yamanote Line

From Haneda Airport, take the **Keikyu Line** to Shinagawa Station (station number: KK01) and change trains to the **JR Yamanote Line** that goes in the direction of Shibuya. Get off at Shinjuku Station (station number: JY17). It takes about a 15-minute walk from the west exit of Shinjuku Station to the hotel.

(3) By taxi

Time required is approximately 45-60 minutes. Fare to be around JPY 8,000-12,000.

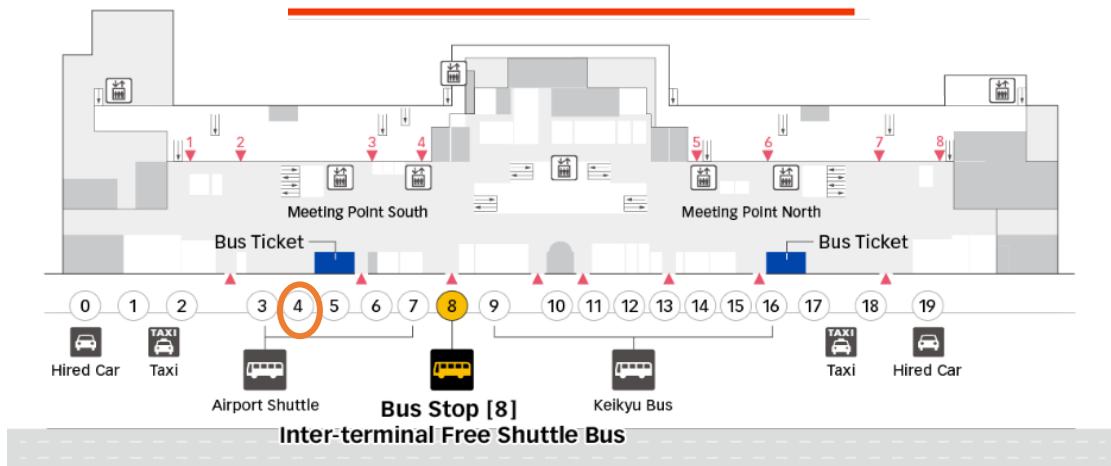

# Bus Stop Map of Haneda Airport

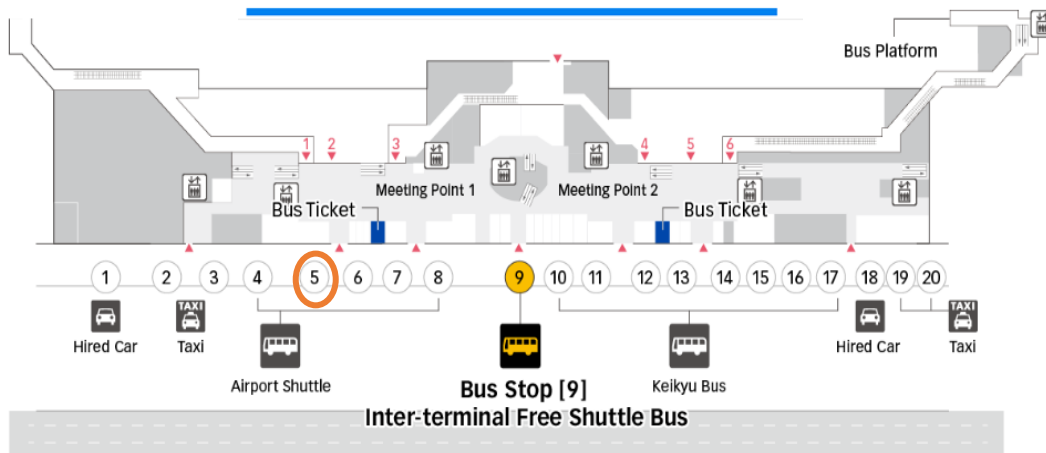

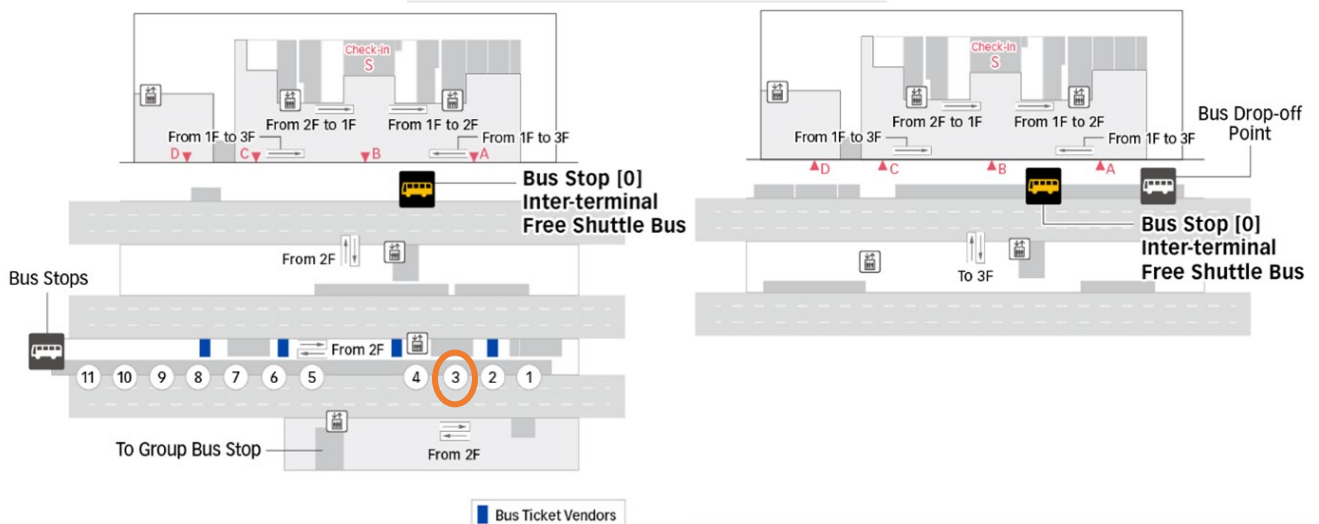

Duration: approx. 120 minutes.

Fare: Adult JPY 3,200

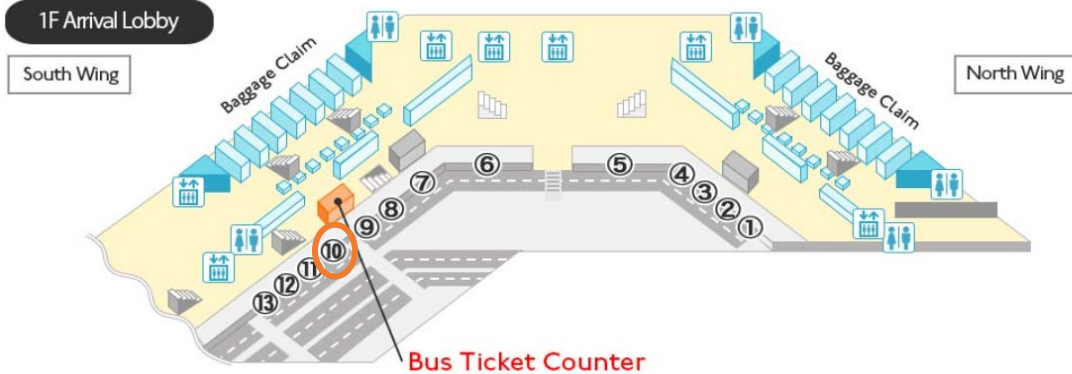
### (3) By Taxi

## Bus Stop Map of Narita Airport

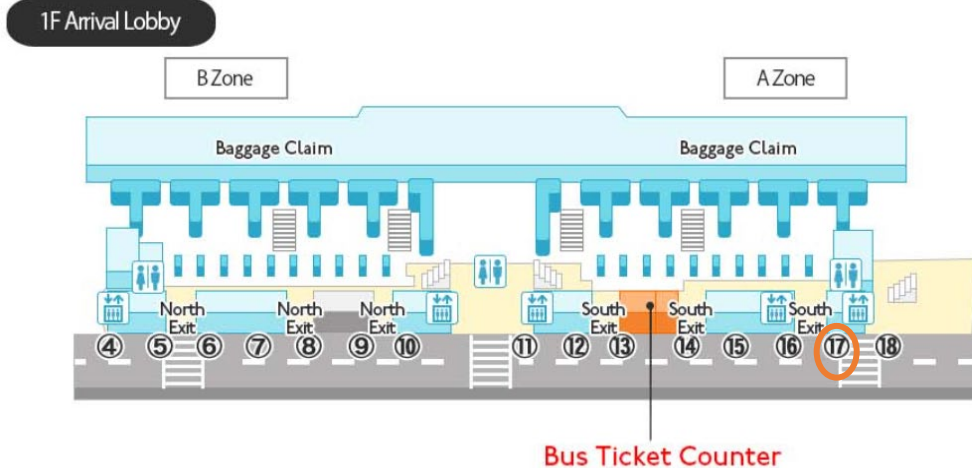
### Narita Airport Terminal 1

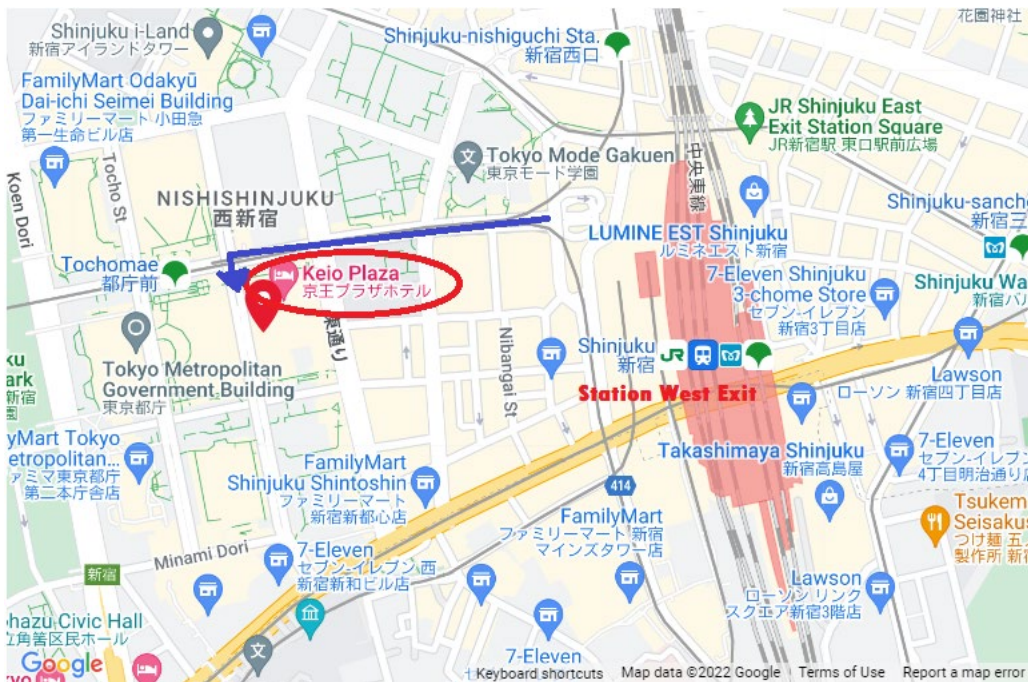

## 4. Other Travel Information

### (1) Electronic Devices

The voltage for all electric appliances is 100 volts/50 HZ. Most electrical outlets in Japan take a two flat parallel prong plugs (Type A). For guaranteed charging of your electrical necessities, please prepare a plug adapter beforehand.



### (2) Currency

The Japanese yen is used throughout the country and you can exchange foreign currency at the airports and most major banks.

Even though Japan is a cash-centric country, credit cards are usually accepted in most shops, restaurants and taxis in major cities.

### (3) Weather

November in Japan is pleasantly crisp. The average outdoor temperature is around 13 degrees Celsius (maximum 17 degrees, minimum 10 degrees). The conference room is temperature controlled and air-conditioned. However, it is suggested that you bring along a jacket and jersey/pullover. It is suggested that you bring extra clothes to stay warm. It is usually cool in the evening.

### (4) Drinking Water

While bottled water is readily available all over Japan—including in the infinite vending machines—the tap water is perfectly safe to drink.
