## 4. Other Travel Information

## (1) Electronic Devices

The voltage for all electric appliances is 100 volts $/ 50 \mathrm{HZ}$. Most electrical outlets in Japan take a two flat parallel prong plugs (Type A). For guaranteed charging of your electrical necessities, please prepare a plug adapter beforehand.


## (2) Currency

The Japanese yen is used throughout the country and you can exchange foreign currency at the airports and most major banks.
Even though Japan is a cash-centric country, credit cards are usually accepted in most shops, restaurants and taxis in major cities.

## (3) Weather

November in Japan is pleasantly crisp. The average outdoor temperature is around 13 degrees Celsius (maximum 17 degrees, minimum 10 degrees). The conference room is temperature controlled and air-conditioned. However, it is suggested that you bring along a jacket and jersey/pullover. It is suggested that you bring extra clothes to stay warm. It is usually cool in the evening.

## (4) Drinking Water

While bottled water is readily available all over Japan-including in the infinite vending machines-the tap water is perfectly safe to drink.
