

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# 2022 Population and Housing Census (Register-based Census)



As of November 1st, 2022, the population of South Korea was 51.69 million persons, which decreased by 0.1% (-46 thousand persons) from 2021.

## $\bigcirc$ (Koreans and foreigners)

In 2022, the number of Koreans residing in South Korea was 49.94 million persons (96.6% of the total population), which decreased by 0.3% (-148 thousand persons) from 2021. The number of foreigners residing in South Korea recorded 1.75 million persons (3.4% of the total population), which increased by 6.2% (102 thousand persons) from 2021.




#### ○ (Age structure)

The working age population aged 15~64 occupied 71.0% (36.69 million persons). The elderly population aged 65 or more occupied 17.7% (9.15 million persons). The youth population aged 0~14 occupied 11.3% (5.86 million persons).

- Compared to 2021, the youth population and the working age population dropped by 228 thousand persons (-3.7%) and 258 thousand persons (-0.7%), respectively. Whereas, the elderly population rose by 440 thousand persons (5.1%).
- Compared to 2017, the share of the working age population declined by 2.1%p (-883 thousand persons).

## ○ (Aging index)


The aging index (the elderly population per 100 youth population) stood at 156.1 in 2022, rising by 13.1 from 2021.

- The aging index of Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 225.9. Whereas, the aging index of Sejong recorded the lowest figure of 53.3.

## $\bigcirc$ (Population by region)

10 regions (excluding Incheon, Sejong, Gyeonggi, Gangwon, Chungbuk, Chungnam and Jeju) showed a year-on-year decrease in the population.

- Compared to 2021, among 4 areas, the population of the Capital Area and the Jungbu Area increased by 0.2% and 0.5%, respectively.
- Compared to 2021, 155 administrative districts of Si, Gun & Gu showed a decrease in the population.



# [Household]


In 2022, the number of households totaled 22.38 million households, increasing by 1.6% (360 thousand households) from 2021.

# ○ (Household type)

The general households occupied 97.3% (21.77 million households) of the total households. The other households (foreigners households and group households) occupied 2.7% (610 thousand households).

- Compared to 2021, the general households and the other households increased by 325 thousand households (1.5%) and 35 thousand households (6.2%), respectively.
- Among general households, relative households, non-relative households and 1-person households occupied 63.2%, 2.4% and 34.5%, respectively.


< Figure > Total households and average annual household growth rate (1980~2022)



## $\bigcirc$ (Household size)

Compared to 2021, 1-person, 2-person and 3-person households marked an increase. In the meantime, 4-person or more households marked a decrease.

- Compared to 2021, 1-person and 2-person households rose by 4.7% (337 thousand households) and 3.0% (184 thousand households), respectively. Whereas, 4-person or more households fell by 5.2% (-210 thousand households).
- The average household size marked 2.25 persons in 2022, which fell by 0.04 from 2021 and 0.23 from 2017.




< Figure > Household composition by household size (2000~2022)

#### $\bigcirc$ (Living quarters)

The households residing in apartments took up 52.4% in 2022, rising by 0.4%p from 2021.

- As for the share of households residing in apartments by province, Sejong showed the highest figure of 77.5%. Jeju marked the lowest figure of 25.6%.



# [Housing]

In 2022, the number of housing units totaled 19.16 million units, rising by 1.8% (344 thousand units) compared to 2021.

## $\bigcirc$ (Kinds of housing units)

Detached houses totaled 3.86 million units, which fell 0.3% (-10 thousand units) from 2021. Multi-unit dwellings totaled 15.08 million units, which grew 2.4% (355 thousand units) from 2021.

- Apartments amounted to 12.27 million units, which accounted for 64.0% of the total housing units. This figure increased by 2.7% (320 thousand units) from 2021.

## $\bigcirc$ (Housing by region)


As for the year-on-year increase rate of housing units by province, Sejong recorded the highest figure of 4.5%. Gyeongbuk recorded the lowest figure of 0.4%.

 As for the share of apartments by province, Sejong recorded the highest figure of 86.9%. Jeju recorded the lowest figure of 31.7%. As for the share of detached houses by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 48.6%. Incheon recorded the lowest figure of 8.6%.

# $\bigcirc$ (Construction of housing units)

Housing units constructed 20 years ago or more accounted for 52.2% of the total housing units. Housing units constructed 30 years ago or more accounted for 23.5% of the total housing units.

- 54.2% (2.09 million housing units) of detached houses were constructed 30 years ago or more. 14.1% (1.73 million housing units) of apartments were constructed 30 years ago or more.
- As for the share of housing units constructed 30 years ago or more by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 38.9%, which was followed by Gyeongbuk (33.1%) and Jeonbuk (31.8%). Sejong recorded the lowest figure of 7.1%.



 $\bigcirc$  (Average residence households per detached house)

The average residence households per detached house stood at 1.9 households. The average residence households per general detached house stood at 1.0 household. The average residence households per multi-unit detached house stood at 3.9 households. The average residence households per detached house to be used for dwelling as well as business purpose stood at 2.8 households.

# [1-person households]

In 2022, 1-person households marked 7.50 million households (34.5%), rising by 4.7% from 2021.

## $\bigcirc$ (Average annual growth rate)



## $\bigcirc$ (Age structure)

As for 1-person households by age group, '29 or less' recorded the highest share at 19.2%, which was followed by '30~39' (17.3%) and '60~69' (16.7%). As for 1-person households of males by age group, '30~39' recorded the highest share at 22.0%. As for 1-person households of females by age group, '29 or less' recorded the highest share at 18.9%.

## $\bigcirc$ (1-person households by province)

As for the share of 1-person households by province, Daejeon recorded the highest figure of 38.5%, Whereas, Ulsan and Gyeonggi recorded the lowest figure of 30.2%.




< Figure > Share of 1-person households (1980~2022)

# [Elderly population]

In 2022, the elderly population aged 65 or more recorded 9.05 million persons, rising by 4.9% (426 thousand persons) from 2021.

# $\bigcirc$ (Elderly population by region)

The elderly population aged 65 or more in Myeon regions occupied the largest share at 34.2%, which was 2.1 times higher than that in Dong regions (16.3%).



# [Multi-cultural households]

In 2022, the multi-cultural households amounted to 399 thousand households, rising by 3.7% (14 thousand households) from 2021.


# ○ (Multi-cultural households)

The multi-cultural households totaled 399 thousand households. Among them, the households of naturalized Koreans and marriage immigrants occupied 42.8% and 37.2%, respectively. The households of multi-cultural children and the other households occupied 11.1% and 8.9%, respectively.

# $\bigcirc$ (Nationality of naturalized Koreans and marriage immigrants)

Korean-Chinese occupied the largest share of 32.3%, which was followed by Vietnamese (21.8%) and Chinese (19.0%).
